

Adopted and signed during the 5th Ministerial Conference "Environment for Europe" in Kyiv, May 2003

by Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Serbia and Montenegro, Slovakia and Ukraine

*The Process:

- Request to UNEP-ROE by Ukraine: 2001
- COP I: Kyiv, Ukraine, December 2006
- Entered into force: January 4, 2006
- COP II: Bucharest, Romania, June 2008
 - Protocol on Conservation and Sustainable Use of Biological and Landscape Diversity

The Carpathian Principles

- *framework for cooperation and multisectoral policy coordination
- *platform for joint strategies for sustainable development
- forum for dialogue between all stakeholders involved
- Cooperation with other mountain Conventions
